

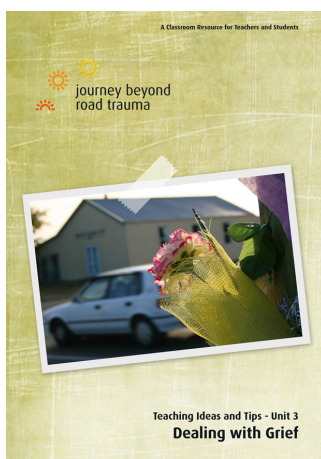
An online community for people affected by road trauma

Journey Beyond Road Trauma is a resource for everyone who cares about road safety and school communities that wish to educate their students about safe driving practices.

JBRT is a powerful educational resource that teachers can use to impart and share road trauma experiences and consequences to students. Through the power of the personal story, teachers can engage students and effectively educate them to act responsibly and to make informed decisions to protect the safety of themselves and others.

Focusing on the behavioural impact of licit substances such as alcohol and pharmaceuticals, the JBRT Classroom Resources, which are sponsored by the AER Foundation, will educate students about possible vulnerabilities and will highlight the potential dangers of abuse.

The JBRT multimedia platform provides teachers with a motivational tool for interactive learning in the 21st century classroom. With web based content and resources, a teacher will be able to conduct a JBRT unit of study entirely digitally.



There are five classroom study units:

- Unit 1 Consequences of High Risk Driving Behaviours
- Unit 2 Driving and Prescription Drugs (Pharmaceuticals)
- Unit 3 Dealing with Grief
- Unit 4 Tragic Consequences of Driver Fatigue
- Unit 5 Developing Cognitive Reasoning Skills for Personal Behaviour Assessment

Whilst JBRT has cross-curricula appeal across PDHPE, Life Skills and Family and Community Studies, it is within the personal development and pastoral curriculum where it has the most direct relevance. JBRT also has learning resource value for Distance Education and Home Schooling.
